JAMES ROBERTSON OF KINDROCHET c1750-1823

Born Kindrochet [?] c1750; died Kindrochet August 1823. Eldest son of Duncan Robertson of Kindrochet.

Married 1776 [marriage contract dated 30 March 1776] Jean Stewart [died 1818], eldest daughter of William Stewart, Dalchalloch, formerly tacksman of Miln of Blair Atholl, by whom he had seven children, three sons and four daughters, of whom presently. In 1822 he assigned the estate of Kindrochet to his eldest son Duncan Robertson. He reserved for himself "a small pendicle of land called Andraigh, close to the Errochty, near Kindrochet Cottage", which he left in his will to his three unmarried daughters Helen, Elizabeth and Anne. ¹

DUNCAN ROBERTSON OF KINDROCHET

Born c1778; died 1837. Captain Duncan Robertson of Kindrochet, eldest son of James Robertson of Kindrochet c1750-1823 and his wife Jean Stewart. Captain 88th Regiment of Foot (1st Connaught Rangers); the estate of Kindrochet was assigned to him by his father in 1822. He retired on half pay when his father died in the following year.

Married 1816 SOPHIA STEWART c1779-1861, youngest daughter of Donald Stewart of Shierglass and his wife Sophia, daughter of John Stewart of Bonskeid. Marriage Contract dated 12 April 1816 drawn up by Duncan Stewart writer in

Married Sydney, Cape Breton, 21 January 1806 Amelia Elizabeth Campbell otherwise Elizabeth Amelia Campbell 1789-1855, generally known as Eliza; daughter of William Campbell, Attorney-General of Cape Breton Island. SOPHIA HELEN ROBERTSON

Third of the six daughters of Dr William Robertson of Montreal and Eliza Campbell. Generally known as Sophie.

Married in 1845 W R Ross by whom she had two sons, Alexander and William. The latter married Julia Hobson and had four daughters.

6 MARY LOUISA ROBERTSON

Fourth of the six daughters of Dr William Robertson of Montreal and Eliza Campbell. Generally known as Louisa.

Married firstly Captain W Zuhlke, by whom she had a son George Zuhlke who married S Bridges. Married secondly M F MacCulloch, by whom had four sons William, Ferdinand, Robertson and Harry, and one daughter Emily.

7 CATHERINE ROBERTSON

Fifth of the six daughter of Dr William Robertson of Montreal and Eliza Campbell. Generally known as Kate.

Married Angus Hooper by whom she had two sons Angus and George, and one daughter Maud.

Born 5 August 1829; died 5 July 1887. Third of the four sons of Dr William Robertson of Montreal and Eliza Campbell.

Married his distant cousin Grace Amelia Stewart, daughter of Dr John Stewart of Findynate, by whom he had three sons John Stewart Robertson [md Honor ---, no issue], Duncan Stewart Robertson [died unmarried] and William Stewart Robertson [died unmarried], and daughter Grace who was born in 1866 and died unmarried.

Youngest son of Dr William Robertson of Montreal and Eliza Campbell. Married A Marling & had one daughter Edith who married Hector McNeil.
